Covid Appropriate Behavior:- a) The installation of sanitizer machines in the college campus of Nutan Nahavidyalay , Selu. b) The PSSC Cell of the college has displayed awareness boards with giving instruction as guideline for appropriate behavior against covid. c) Maximum staff of the college has completed two doses of vaccine against covid.



d) The counseling of student for appropriate behavior and it important is done.

e) Student and teachers of the college voluntary worked to maintain social distance against covid at several public places.

2. Promotion for Vaccination:

a) The survey on vaccination is done for the city Selu in which the data is collected by oral interview throw quiz .

b) One day workshop is conducted on awareness of vaccination in which Dr. Sanjay Harbade medical superintendent(SDH) Selu and adviser disaster management was the chef speaker he has given detail information about both vaccine covishield and cowaxin. There were more than hundred participants in this workshop. It was made available one live youtube channel.

c) The vaccination camp is conducted in the collage for students, parents and other social members. it was inaugurated by dr. Sanjay Harbade as the president of the program Mr. Vinod Borade mayor of town was present as the guest of honor, Dr. Mahendra Shinde as a in charge principal , Dr.N. S. Padmavat mentor PSSC cell senior collage , Mr. Nagesh Kanhekar mentor junior college , Mr. Mahesh Kulkarni, dr. Kirti Niralwad as member of PSSC cell Mr. Akash Dhakarge, Mr. Mahadev Raut as student representative, PSSC cell were present for this program. dr. Sanjay Harbade with his team completed successfully this vaccination camp in which 50 people were vaccinated.

3. Collaboration with Local health Authority:

a) Dr. Sanjay Harbade, Medical superintendent, Sub District Hospital Selu is attached with PSSC Cell Nutan Mahavidyalaya Selu as adviser disaster Management Selu.

- a) Students volunteers collected data through door to door survey and taken interviews of Covid patient.
- b) Students volunteers tried to give moral support to these patients and their families.
- c) The food and other daily needs products are provided to these patients by PSSC cell of Nutan Mahavidyalaya, Selu.
- d) The team of PSSC cell has conducted interviews of vegetable vendor lady, the working+house-wife, ambulance driver, the nurse, the person working at funeral place, the employees of Nagar Parishad Selu, who completed the rituals of funerals of covid-19 patients, social workers who helped in this entire process to protect Selu town from corona etc.

5. Networking With Government, NGOs, Civil Society Organization:

- a) Managing body members of the college are part of Mahesh Rugn Seva Mandal, Selu who provided food to those who stayed at Shriramji Bhangdiyaji Hostel Selu.
- b) Late. Nitin Lahane Cricket Association is established by Alumni of the College who also provided food to those who stayed at Shriramji Bhangdiyaji Hostel Selu.
- c) Maurya Pratisthan timely supported to the college to communicate with local and nearby locality for the awareness about covid and precautions to be taken against Covid-19.
- d) The college has given sport land to Nagar Parishad Selu for vegetable vendors as the market place which helped to maintain social distance/ physical distance as one of the remedy against covid-19.
- e) The notable contribution of the college and institution is appreciated by Revenue office of Selu and The president, the Principal, the supervisor and one teaching staff is felicitated with the certificate as Cowid-warrior.

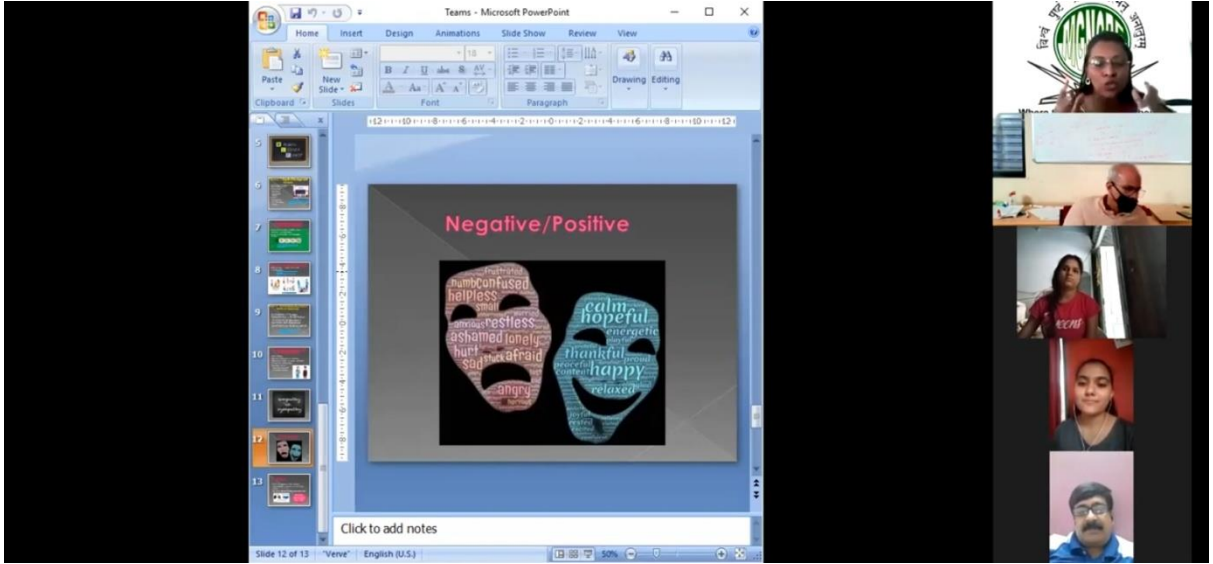
